## Pedo Competencies:

There are 7 types of competencies. They are:

- 1. Comprehensive Oral Evaluation/Case Presentation- Type 2 or 3 Patient
- 2. Recall
- 3. Minor 1 Restorative: an occlusal restoration on a primary or permanent tooth, or 2 or more sealants on permanent teeth
- 4. Major 2 Restorative: either a class II restoration on a primary tooth or a pulpotomy or a SSC
- 5. Local Anesthesia
- 6. Prophylaxis
- 7. Caries Risk Assessment (CRA): refer to AAPD Guidelines @ <a href="http://www.aapd.org/media/Policies Guidelines/BP\_CariesRiskAssessment.pdf">http://www.aapd.org/media/Policies Guidelines/BP\_CariesRiskAssessment.pdf</a>

All 7 competencies must be successfully completed to graduate, but at least 1 competency must be successfully completed per semester. If the student has already completed 1 major, then 1 additional major can equal 1 minor. The student must declare to the instructor that they are doing the procedure as a competency prior to the start of the procedure.
