Upper Division General Education

APPLICANTS WITH AN ASSOCIATE DEGREE FROM AN OKLAHOMA INSTITUTION: Excluding an associate degree in "applied sciences", Oklahoma associate degrees waive the following general education requirements: artistic form, western culture, world culture, foreign language requirement, and UCOL 1523, 1533 or 1534. PLEASE NOTE: Completion of 3-hour upper division general education course is still required with an associate degree.

APPLICANTS WITH A BACHELOR'S DEGREE FROM A U.S. INSTITUTION: A bachelor's degree from a U.S. institution waives ALL general education course requirements: artistic form, western culture, world culture, foreign language requirement, UCOL 1523, 1533 or 1534 and 3-hour upper division general education requirement.
